

Inas Gala Regatta February 18 & 19 2016 Nowra Community Sailing Club

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will follow The International Sailing Federation's Racing Rules of Sailing. Some rules will be changed.

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|--------------|--|
| Rule 33 | The course will not be changed after the preparatory signal. |
| Rule 41 | Sailors can get help from safety boats and committee boats. They can only be given help with direction, reefing and bailing. |
| Rule 44.1 | The Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty. |
| Rule 61.1(a) | Sailors do not need to hail "Protest" or fly a red flag but they should if they can. |
| Rule 63.3(a) | Sailors can bring in a support person to help them in a protest. The support person can help through the whole process. |

1.2 The changes to the rules will be written in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions might also change other racing rules.

1.3 The Hansaclass association membership rule will not be used (rule 87, rule C.6).

1.4 English is the language of this regatta. The English ISAF rules will be used.

2. ENTRY

2.1 Entry is open to the following sailors.

- Classified sailors are those on the Inas master list with at least Inas Provisional Eligibility.
- Eligible non-classified sailors are those who are provisionally eligible for Inas classification.
- Companion sailors need not be eligible for Inas classification.



2.2 To enter, fill in the entry form attached to NOR. Return to Regatta Secretary.

2.3. Hansa 2.3 and Hansa 303 classes will be sailed.

3. DIVISIONS

Division 1	One person (1 x Inas sailor)	Hansa 2.3
Division 2	Two person (2 x Inas sailors)	Hansa 303
Division 3	Two person (1 x Inas sailor + companion)	Hansa 303

Racing will be conducted in the following divisions, providing there are 3 or more entries for the division.

4. FEES

4.1 Entry Fees

- a) Hansa 2.3 One Person division AUD\$40
 - b) Hansa 303 Two Person divisions AUD\$60
- Payment may be made at Registration.

5. CALENDAR

5.1 Thursday February 18 – Greys Beach boat ramp Fairway Drive, North Nowra

- a) Registration 9am to 10am
- b) Equipment checks 9am to 10am
- c) Sailors meeting/Meal break 10am
- d) Practice racing 11am to 4pm

5.2 Friday February 19 – NCSC Wharf Road, Nowra

- a) Briefing 10am
- b) Racing 11am
- c) Each division will sail up to 6 races.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailors will be given the sailing instructions at registration. They might also be online.

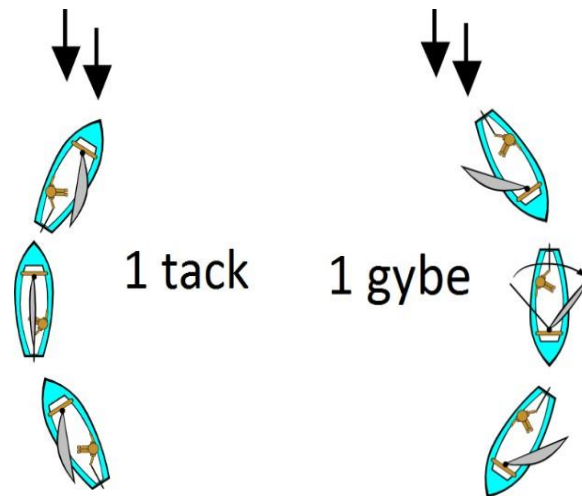
7. THE COURSES

Boats will sail Trapezoid, Triangle or Windward-Leeward courses. They will be written in the Sailing Instructions.



8. PENALTIES

On-water penalties will be one turn penalties. This changes rule 44.1.



9. SCORING

The event will be 4 races or more.

- If 0-4 races have been sailed, there will be no scores dropped.
- If 5-8 races have been sailed, each boat's worst score will be dropped.
- If 12 or more races have been sailed, each boat's 2 worst scores will be dropped.

10. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boat drivers must sign on at registration.

11. TAKING BOATS OUT OF THE WATER

Boats may be removed from the water during the event.

12. PRIZES

- Inas One Person Championship 1st , 2nd , 3rd
- Inas Two Person Championship 1st , 2nd , 3rd
- Inas Two Person Supported Championship 1st , 2nd , 3rd
- Other prizes might also be awarded.



13. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Sailors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. This is in The Racing Rules of Sailing, rule 4. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14. **MEDIA**

The organisers and sponsors might take photographs and videos of the sailors. Sailors give permission for these to be used with no restrictions.

15. **INSURANCE**

Every boat must have insurance. It must be current third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of AUD \$5 million per incident or the equivalent.
